## Technology and Communications

An annual technology and communications fee is charged to each student to cover the cost of wireless internet access. Use of phone and internet is regulated by parental and school rules.

## Private Instruction

All Music majors are required to take twenty-four, one-hour private music lessons per school year. Juniors and seniors who declare Musical Theatre as their concentration are required to take twenty, one-hour private voice lessons per school year.

## Student Medical Insurance

A student medical insurance policy is mandatory for all boarding and day students. Evidence of medical insurance coverage acceptable by local physicians and hospitals must be provided to the Health Center before a student can stay in the dorms or participate in any programs. Parents are encouraged to purchase medical insurance through the plan offered by Idyllwild Arts.

## Medical and Dental Care

Parents will be asked to complete a detailed health profile for their student over the summer, which must include proof of immunization and current tuberculosis test required by the state of California. All routine medical and dental care should be completed prior to the opening of school in the fall, or attended to during the periods of fall, winter, and spring holidays. All students must have complete health profiles and be up to date on all required immunizations before staying in the dorms or participating in any programs.

## Transportation

The school provides vehicle transportation to Ontario, Los Angeles, and Palm Springs airports for scheduled breaks and vacation. The school also provides transportation for other purposes, such as auditions and medical appointments. Schedules are provided to parents at the beginning of the school year. All transportation fees will be charged to student's incidental account.

## Laundry

Washers and dryers are provided in the dormitories for use by the students, free of charge.

## Personal Property

Idyllwild Arts does not accept liability for students' belongings at the school. We suggest that parents include their student's belongings in their homeowners insurance.

## Tuition Insurance

Idyllwild Arts Academy has elected to participate in a student tuition insurance program that is designed to protect your tuition obligation should your child be withdrawn or dismissed from school. We have selected TuitionNet to provide this coverage. TuitionNet provides for the partial refund of tuition charges, according to the terms of the plan, if the child is withdrawn or dismissed from the School.

Coverage is required for all student accounts on payment plans that extend into the school year. It is optional for student accounts that are paid in full prior to the start of the school year.

## Tuition Payment Management

Idyllwild Arts uses Smart Tuition for their online tuition and fees management. Each family is required to set up an account with Smart Tuition and will have that same account throughout the course of their child's enrollment at Idyllwild Arts. Families will be prompted to create a new account (or login into your old account if student is returning) once you pay your child's tuition deposit through the Admission Office.

## Incidental Account Management

Idyllwild Arts uses Campus Card Account, an incidental billing management system, to manage student charges that take place on campus throughout the year. Once signed up for Campus Card Account, you will be able to view your child's incidental account and monitor their spending as it happens. Students can only use their ID cards to make purchases if there is an incidental deposit on their account. If you have not paid an incidental deposit, you can do so by paying the deposit through the Finance Office, or you can add funds directly to your Campus Card Account via credit card.

## Payment Plans

The Arts Academy provides options for families who wish to finance their student's education through flexible payment plans. Contact the Admission Office for more information.

## Homestay Program

Idyllwild Arts Academy provides homestays for boarding students who need to stay in Idyllwild over fall, winter, or spring break. Homestay hosts are school employees, and groups of homestay students may be housed in a school property on or off campus, or at a homestay host's house in Idyllwild or Pine Cove.

## Guardianship

All boarding students are required to have a parent or guardian on file who can pick them up when asked to do so by the School in case of an emergency. Parents or guardians in California are expected to pick up their students within 48 hours of an emergency. All other parents or guardians outside California are required to pick up their students within 96 hours of an emergency. If a family does not have a local guardian, there are several companies that offer guardianship services.

In the case of some emergencies, a student may require care at a facility off campus (students needing in-patient care at a local hospital, for example). In cases like these, the School will coordinate with the student's parents/guardians and student services staff will stay with the student until their parent or guardian can arrive. The school may bill the student's family for any expenses associated with providing more than 12 hours of off-site care for students in these situations.
