#### **TECHNOLOGY AND COMMUNICATIONS**

The \$350 Technology Fee supports access to high-speed internet and essential student hardware like computers and tablets, ensuring seamless digital learning. It also covers software licensing, including Adobe Creative Cloud, giving students access to creative and academic tools, supports ongoing maintenance and IT support to keep the network and devices running smoothly. Additionally, the fee covers Titan HST, our emergency communication system, that provides a method for students to communicate to our Emergency Response Team in case of an emergency. This investment ensures our students safety and provides our students with the technology needed to excel in a modern learning environment.

#### **HEALTH + WELLNESS CENTERS**

The Health Center is open 12-16 hours per day with licensed nurses on staff and on call to provide care at all hours of the day and night, when needed. Our nurses administer and track medication, coordinate appointments with medical providers, accompany students in ambulance and hospital in case of emergency.

The Idyllwild Arts Academy Wellness Center is open Monday through Friday 9:00am-5:00pm and provides school counseling services for Social Emotional support. The Wellness Center's goal for the school year is to provide Social Emotional Learning to ALL persons on campus. This is to promote the overall well-being, retention, and success of our diverse student population.

# STUDENT MEDICAL INSURANCE

A student medical insurance policy is mandatory for all boarding and day students. Evidence of medical insurance coverage acceptable by local physicians and hospitals must be provided to the Health Center before a student can stay in the dorms or participate in any programs. International parents are required to purchase medical insurance through the plan offered by Idyllwild Arts.

#### **MEDICAL AND DENTAL CARE**

Parents will be asked to complete a detailed health profile for their student over the summer, which must include proof of immunization and current tuberculosis test required by the state of California. All routine medical and dental care should be completed prior to the opening of school in the fall, or attended to during the periods of fall, winter, and spring holidays. All students must have complete health profiles and be up to date on all required immunizations before staying in the dorms or participating in any programs.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

The school provides vehicle transportation to Ontario, Los Angeles, and Palm Springs airports for scheduled breaks and vacation. The school also provides transportation for other purposes, such as auditions and medical appointments. Schedules are provided to parents at the beginning of the school year. All transportation fees will be charged to student's incidental account.

#### **LAUNDRY**

Washers and dryers are provided in the dormitories for use by the students, free of charge.

#### PERSONAL PROPERTY

Idyllwild Arts does not accept liability for students' belongings at the school. We suggest that parents include their student's belongings in their homeowners insurance.

#### **TUITION INSURANCE**

Idyllwild Arts Academy has elected to participate in a student tuition insurance program that is designed to protect your tuition obligation should your child be withdrawn or dismissed from school.

Coverage is required for all student accounts on payment plans that extend into the school year. It is optional for student accounts that are paid in full prior to the start of the school year. However, tuition insurance is highly recommended for everyone.

## **TUITION PAYMENT MANAGEMENT**

Idyllwild Arts uses Tuition Management for their online tuition and fees management. Each family is required to set up an account with Tuition Management and will have that same account throughout the course of their child's enrollment at Idyllwild Arts. Families will be prompted to create a new account (or login into your old account if student is returning) once you pay your child's tuition deposit through the Admission Office.

### **INCIDENTAL ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT**

Idyllwild Arts uses Campus Card Account, an incidental billing management system, to manage student charges that take place on campus throughout the year. Once signed up for Campus Card Account, you will be able to view your child's incidental account and monitor their spending as it happens. Students can only use their ID cards to make purchases if there is an incidental deposit on their account. If you have not paid an incidental deposit, you can do so by paying the deposit through the Finance Office, or you can add funds directly to your Campus Card Account via credit card.

#### **PAYMENT PLANS**

The Arts Academy provides options for families who wish to finance their student's education through flexible payment plans. Contact the Admission Office for more information.

# **HOMESTAY PROGRAM**

Idyllwild Arts Academy provides homestays for boarding students who need to stay in Idyllwild over fall or spring break. Homestay hosts are school employees, and groups of homestay students may be housed in a school property on or off campus, or at a homestay host's house in Idyllwild or Pine Cove.
