

IDYLLWILD ARTS ACADEMY is located in a mountain environment, and temperatures may vary greatly daily. Our winter season includes rain, snow, and temperatures below freezing. Since storage space is limited, clothing and belongings should be selected carefully and “extras” should be kept to a minimum. Every dorm room is furnished with Twin beds, a built-in closet, chairs, and a desk with the dimensions 42” L x 24” W x 30” H. Storage under beds can fit a long, flat bin no higher than 12”.



ITEMS TO BRING

- Warm jacket, gloves, hat, and boots resistant to snow and rain
 - Umbrella
 - Light jacket or sweater
 - Tennis shoes/sneakers
 - Shorts and tee shirts
 - Swimsuit
 - Telephone
 - Blankets or quilts (2)
 - Comforter
 - Bedspread
 - Sheets, twin size (2)
 - Pillows & pillow cases (2)
 - Towels & washcloths
 - Laundry bags
 - Hangers
 - Flashlight
 - Toilet articles
 - Laundry soap
 - Cleaning supplies
 - Writing materials
 - Study or reading lamp
 - Desk supplies
 - Trunk or box in which student may lock personal possessions
 - Mouse-proof metal or hard plastic food storage containers - required for any/all food, beverages, snacks, tea, candy, etc. in dorm rooms
 - Book bag or day pack (1 required)
 - TI-83 or TI-84 calculator (sufficient for all math classes) **or**
 - TI-30XIIS calculator (recommended for physics and higher-level math)
 - Although the Academy maintains a computer lab, students are required to bring their own computers. See Student/Parent Handbook.
 - Intel Core i5, i7 or i9 (Skylake or more recent), AMD equivalent or Apple Silicon
 - At least 16GB RAM
 - At least 256GB storage
 - 802.11n, or 802.11ac Wireless capabilities

ITEMS NOT TO BRING

- Televisions
- Furniture that is too big for one person to carry
- Torch halogen lamps
- Skateboards and scooters (including e-powered)
- Weapons of any kind
- Candles or incense
- Pets
- Computer monitors larger than 32 inches
- Toaster ovens
- Space Heaters

KITCHEN AND COOKING ITEMS

For fire safety and hygiene reasons, cooking is not allowed in dorm rooms.

- Each dorm room includes a **shared mini-fridge** for you and your roommate.
- The **only appliance permitted in dorm rooms** is a **water kettle with an automatic shutoff**.
- A **shared kitchen** is available in each dorm for student use.
- You may **store cooking appliances** (such as hot pots, air fryers, or rice cookers) in the dorm office and use them in the shared dorm kitchen **on a limited basis**.
- Please bring your own **utensils, bowls, cups, and plates** for personal use in the shared dorm kitchen.
